|  | Cpl. Charles P. Gaffney Jr. | 42 | Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2 nd Battalion, 506 th Infantry Regiment, 4 th Brigade Combat Team, 101 st Airborne Division, XVIII Airborne Corps | Phoenix, Arizona | Killed during a rocket attack at a combat outpost in Paktika Province, Afghanistan on December 24, 2008 |
